The majority of information collated by the Forum has been through anecdotal evidence provided by the Police, County Drug Unit, County Youth Service, Robert Smyth School, Kibworth High School and Community College and the Community Drug Team, using the National Drug Misuse Database.

Gaps exist between the sharing and compiling of information to provide a sound basis for the introduction of treatment and other services for drug users and target areas using a community development model. The available information provides a snapshot of the District. Areas of identified concern to date are:-

- Harborough Leisure Centre
- Memorial Gardens in Town Centre, Market Harborough
- The Welland Park and Periphery
- Shropshire Close, Market Harborough
- Periphery and routes to Robert Smythe School
- Kibworth Medical Centre grounds at night
- Little Bowden Recreation ground
- Co-op/Tesco's Car Park Market Harborough
- Broughton Astley Town Centre
