In addition to the specific consultation arrangements contained in the above tables each parish council will be sent a notice for public display in the locality setting out the particular proposals relevant to that parish. Full details of the proposals and consultation arrangements will also be published on the Council's website and be made subject of a press release. The Leicestershire and Rutland Association of Parish and Local Councils and the Chief Executive of Leicestershire County Council will also be consulted on these proposals.

Consultation Timetable

It is proposed that consultation letters be sent out by the end of October and that a period of 6 weeks given for responses to be made (expiring 14th December 2012).

It is further proposed that the parish poll for Kibworth Beauchamp and Kibworth Harcourt be organised to take place during early December.

The Community Governance Review Committee will then need to meet in January 2013 to consider the consultation responses and agree final recommendation to be made to Council in February 2013.

Community Governance Review – Market Harborough

A separate Community Governance review has been proposed to determine public support for an option to create a parish (town) council for Market Harborough. It is proposed that this review formally commence upon completion of the current review in March 2013.

In the interim period the Community Governance Review Committee will need to consider and agree the terms of reference for the Market Harborough review and a document setting out the advantages and disadvantages of such a proposal for public debate.
