SECTION 119 – HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
PROPOSED DIVERSION OF FOOTPATH X18 (PART) & X31 (PART) AT WOOD FARM, LUTTERWORTH.

An application has been received for the diversion of footpath X18 (Part) & X31 (Part) at Wood Farm, Lutterworth, as shown on Plan No. 1977/P1 attached hereto.

The diversion has been requested in the interest of the applicant to facilitate better management of agricultural land.

I have consulted with the Director of Community Services, who has stated that should the proposal be approved, the alternative footpath will be subject to the following conditions:-

- The proposed alternative route having a minimum specified width of 2.0 metres.
- The waymarker post currently located at point 'D' on the attached Plan Number 1977/P1 should be removed.
- The provision of a waymarker post, to the specification of the Leicestershire County Council, at point 'H' on the attached Plan Number 1977/P1.

I should be pleased if you would let me have your council's observations on this proposal by the 16th December 2004.
