**PROPOSED DIVERSION OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH C36 BY THE RIVER SENCE,  
WISTOW**

An application has been received for the diversion of Public Footpath C36 at Wistow, as shown on Plan No. 1995/P attached hereto.

The diversion has been requested as the legal line of the originally footpath, points A to B on Plan No. 1995/P, has been lost through erosion. The public have taken to walking around the meandering River Scene, as shown on Plan No. 1995/P as A, C and B, and thus this proposed diversion will correct the Definite Map to reflect this.

I have consulted with the Director of Community Services, who has stated that should the proposal be approved, the alternative footpath will be subject to the following condition:-

- The proposed alternative route having a minimum specified width of 1.80 metres.

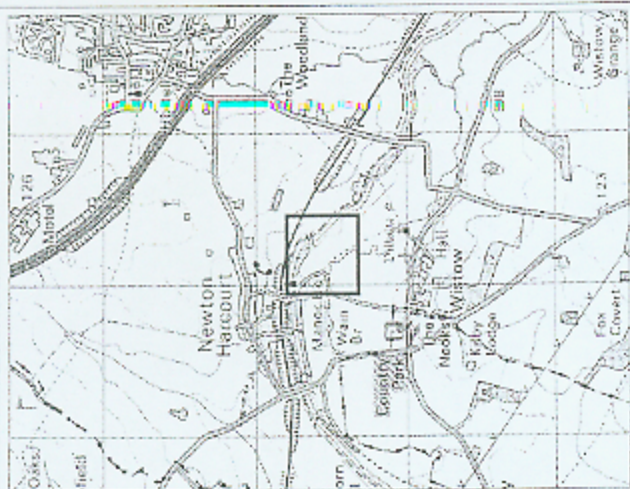

# Proposed Diversion of Public Footpath C36 By The River Sence, at Wistow

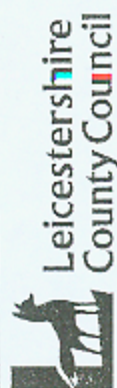
## Location Plan
