

How do I find affordable housing in the district?

You can apply to join the housing register, Harbourough Home Search, by applying online at www.harborough-homes.org.uk

Once your application has been assessed you will be notified of your reference number, your assessed housing need band and how to bid for vacant housing association properties each fortnight.

Whilst the majority of housing association properties are advertised through Harbourough Home Search some housing associations also maintain their own housing register. You could contact them to see if you can register with them as well.

Sometimes we advertise properties available to rent from private landlords on our website. If you see something that is suitable for you, contact the Housing Options Team for more information (details on back page).

Alternatively you could register with local letting agents or search on the internet for properties available to rent in the private sector. You could also look in local newspapers and publications.
