

- (vi) Not to interfere with the floodlights pre pay mechanism at any time without the written permission of the Council and to keep the combination for the meter box secret.

Payments

- (vii) To pay the Council on execution hereof the sum of £1.00 (one pound)
- (viii) To pay the Council the sum of £2.00 per month for the use of the tennis courts to be paid once per year to the Council. Charges for the floodlights will be made through the pre pay meter and will be the responsibility of the club.
- (ix) To pay the charges for the flood lights via the coin pay system if needed. Charges to be set by the Council.
- (x) Not to erect any pitch side advertising without the consent of the Council.

Play

- (xi) The Club shall be limited to the following sessions per calendar week
 - Wednesday 4 pm - 6 pm 2 courts for junior coaching
 - Wednesday 7 pm - 10 pm 4 courts for clubnight
 - Friday 9.30 am - 11 am 2 courts for adult coaching
 - Friday 4 pm - 6 pm 2 courts for junior coaching
 - Friday 6.30 pm - 8 pm 2 courts for adult coaching
 - Saturday 9.30 am - 12.30 pm 2 courts for junior coaching
 - Saturday 2 pm - 5 pm 4 courts for club afternoon
 - Sunday 10 am - 12 pm 5 courts for junior and adult coaching
- (xii) The club to ensure that a minimum of one court is available at all times for public use..
- (xiii) The club to ensure that use of the pitch does not cause undue risk to participants with games suspended during unsuitable weather.

Court Maintenance

- (xiv) To undertake regular litter picks after play to ensure that the courts have a tidy appearance.
- (xv) To be responsible for greasing the tennis court gates on two occasions per annum.
- (xvi) To ensure that sufficient public liability insurance to the amount of XXXXXXXXXX is maintained for the functions of the club.
- (xvii) The club shall work with the Council to seek additional funding for court or other maintenance from funding sources that are accessible only to community bodies or sports clubs.

3 The Council hereby covenants with the Volunteers as follows

- (i) To maintain the tennis courts playing surface and perimeter fencing in a safe and satisfactory condition.
- (ii) To maintain the floodlights in a satisfactory condition
- (iii) To collect the tokens from the pre pay meter as required, and ensure there is a supply of tokens at an agreed location for purchase by the club or others.

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- (i) The Council and the Club shall be entitled to end this Licence by serving not less than six months written notice to the other party..
- (ii) If the stipulations on the part of the Club herein contained shall not be performed or observed it shall be lawful for the council at any time thereafter to determine this Licence

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Any notice under this Licence shall be deemed duly served on the Club if sent by recorded delivery addressed to their last known address and any notice to the Council shall be deemed sufficiently served if sent recorded delivery addressed to the Chief Executive Officer for the time being of the Council at the Council Offices Adam and Eve Street Market Harborough Leicestershire LE16 7AG

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
