

FACILITIES AT Welland Park

Skate Park

The Skate Park is located at the Farndon Road end of the park and incorporates a range of challenging ramps and rails suitable for in-line skaters, skate boarders and BMX users of all abilities.



Play Areas

There is a wide range of exciting facilities including sandpit, swings, slides, climbing frames and much more. All are located centrally within the park.



Open Space

There are many open spaces within the park including areas for football and other sports. A number of benches are located throughout the park. Why not stop and enjoy the surroundings?



Dog Walk

This area provides dog walkers with an opportunity to let dogs off the lead and enjoy the wooded area adjacent to Welland Park Road.



Tennis

There are five hard tennis courts open throughout the year and four grass courts, which open for the summer season. Rackets, balls and courts are available to hire from the ticket office. Please pay the Parks Officer when you play.



Gardens

The rose gardens are located centrally within the park and provide an idyllic setting for relaxing and soaking up the surroundings. Bedding displays change throughout the seasons with themed displays to look out for.



Bowling

There are two bowling greens available for use throughout the summer. The greens are used by a number of local clubs and are available for use by the public. Equipment is available to hire from the ticket office where you can pay when you play.



Putting Green

The putting area is located next to the café. Golfers of all ages can enjoy a range of holes. Please hire your equipment and pay for your round at the ticket office.



Welland Park Café

The café serves park users with a range of hot and cold snacks and refreshments. The menu includes toasted sandwiches, ice creams and a range of delicious home made cakes.

Welland Park Nursery

The Nursery is privately run and provides a wide range of plants for sale to the public. For more information on opening times and the plants available please feel free to call in at the Nursery.

The River Welland

The river meanders its way throughout the park, along the Millennium Mile and through Market Harborough town centre. The river walk runs along the river, providing a tranquil setting to enjoy the wildlife of Welland Park and escape the hustle and bustle of the town centre.

Pond

The pond is located next to the conservation area and provides an invaluable habitat for much of the park's animal and plant life. If you look closely it is possible to identify some more exotic insects and plants.

Conservation Area


With the recent introduction of this area, you will now be able to find some exciting wildlife in a natural setting. Butterflies and insects thrive in this environment.
